ENTRY INFORMATION:

Eligibility:

ASCA agility trials are open to ALL breeds, including mixes. Your dog does NOT have to be registered with ASCA to enter ASCA agility trials. However, to earn titles, you must have a QTracking number or an ASCA Australian Shepherd registration. A QTracking number application is found at ASCA.org and included in this premium.

Height Cards and Measurements ~ Required Measurements:

Dogs entering the jump height classes 20" or less (with height less than or equal to 20"), that do not have a permanent ASCA, AKC or NADAC height card must be measured. Dogs entering 20+" or 24" jump heights are exempt.

Levels:

Exhibitors may, at their discretion, enter at a level higher than they have titled. If they are registered to receive titles, higher level scores will be applied to unearned lower level titles.

Training in the Ring:

ASCA's agility regulations permit exhibitors to "train in the ring." Exhibitors will be eliminated, but not excused. See the ASCA agility rules for details.

Refunds:

No refunds will be granted after the closing date. Refunds, less a \$15 administration fee, will be granted to injured dogs or bitches in season, if the request is accompanied by a veterinarian's letter and provided to the trial secretary no later than noon on Sunday. No refunds will be issued for amounts under \$10.

Move-Ups:

Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted. Pre-trial move-ups must be received by July 31, 2018. Titles can be earned under one judge. Twenty points are required for jumpers & gamblers; thirty points for regular.

Equipment:

Rubberized contact equipment (no slats) will be used. Jumps, including double, tunnels, **displaceable tire, 24 inch weave poles** may be used at the judge's discretion. The a-frame shall be set at 5'3"

Prizes and Awards:

Qualifying and 1st through 4th place ribbons will be awarded in each class. Placements will be combined for 20+ and 24" dogs in all divisions. A rosette will be awarded to dogs finishing their ATCH.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Ace Program:

Any dog 18 months or older can jump one height lower than their Championship Standard Division Height. Any dog 10 years and older can jump two heights lower than their Championship Standard Division height in the *Ace Senior Dog Division*.

The original program is now called the Championship Program.

This trial will be held according to ASCA Agility regulations. Exhibitors, through submission of their entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. The ASCA Agility Rulebook is available at: www.asca.org

- ASCA, GOASC and/or DDTC will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor.
- All dogs must be on a leash when not competing in the ring or at the practice jump.
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create a disturbance may be asked to leave the show site. In such a case, no refunds will be made.
- Entries from individuals who are not in good standing or dogs excused from all or the ASCA agility program will not be accepted.

 - 1.2 Exhibitor/Owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
 - 1.3 Exhibitor/Owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
 - 1.4 Exhibitor/Owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these
 - 1.5 Exhibitor/Owner release ASCA and GOASC (including its officers, directors and members and event organizing committee), DDTC (including its owners, agents and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands, and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. ASCA Service Membership and QT Number Application

In order to have ASCA trial points tracked and to receive titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA QT Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the QT number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum membership type, Service, is required). ASCA membership does not have to be maintained in subsequent years. **It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify previous ASCA points earned when applying for a QT Number.**

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I have to have a QT number to compete?

- You do not need a QT number in order to compete in Agility or Stock, unless you want to earn ASCA titles.
- You will need a QT number to enter an Obedience Trial, Rally Trial, or Tracking Test.
- Your dog does not have to be a purebred to receive a QT number from ASCA.

Why would I need or want a QT number for my dog?

If you would like your dog's points recorded by ASCA, and receive title certificates in the mail for your accomplishments, you will need to obtain a QT number.

What is the total cost for a QT number?

In order to obtain a QT number for your dog, you must be a member. The cost for a basic Service Membership is **\$10 per owner** if not already a current member.

Your membership is good for one year and does not need to be renewed unless you want to obtain another QT number for another dog after your membership has expired.

This membership fee is in addition to the QT number fee of **\$10** per dog.

A QT number is good for the lifetime of the dog. If you only have one dog, the total cost would be **\$20**. For two dogs, the cost would be **\$30**, etc.
